CIRCULAR

Sub: Ph.D Course Work Examination December 2018 – guidelines for the conduct of the examination – issued –

Ref: U.O. No. Ac E.I.A/Ph.d. Course work/2010 dated 12.10.2010

In connection with the conduct of Ph. D. Course Work Examination December 2018, the following guidelines are framed, so as to facilitate for its orderly and successful completion.

1. The examination comprises of the following three papers:
 - (i) Paper I – “Research Methodology”.
 - (ii) Papers II & III based on the research topic.
2. Research scholars who have already acquired an M. Phil Degree are exempted from appearing for Paper I.
3. It has been made mandatory for all research scholars to qualify themselves in the Course Work Examination within a period of two years from the effective date of their respective date of registration for research. It has also been laid down that a period of six months has elapsed after the date of registration for a research scholar to be eligible to apply for admission to the Course Work Examination.
4. The Controller of Examinations will make arrangements for the setting, printing, and supply of the question papers in respect of Paper – I – “Research Methodology” – to the CSS Office. The CSS will make arrangements for the supply of question papers and Hall Tickets to the centres.
5. The Vice-Chairman (CSS) will make arrangements for the setting of the question papers in respect of Papers II & III.
6. **Question paper setting:** In regard to the setting of questions for Papers II & III of the Course Work Examination, the following instructions are issued.
 - i) A list of research scholars appearing for the Course Work Examination, along with the name of the Chairman of the Doctoral Committee and the supervising teachers, will be made available to the Chairman to enable him to get the question paper prepared by the Supervising Teacher concerned.
 - ii) In respect of research scholars who have applied for admission to the Course Work Examination, the Chairman of the respective Doctoral Committee shall obtain from the supervising teacher concerned and forward to the Vice-Chairman (CSS) the question papers intended for each research scholar appearing for the examination, **before 15.12.2018** without fail.

- iii) The Chairman, Doctoral Committee shall ensure that the Question Paper is set in conformity with **the format of the Question Paper attached herewith**.
- iv) The Chairman, Doctoral Committee shall forward the Question Paper intended for each research Scholar appearing for the Course Work Examination, duly approved by the Chairman himself.
- v) There should be two sets of Question Papers with four copies each for each paper. The Question Papers for Paper II & III for every research scholar shall be enclosed in separate envelopes with the following details superscribed:
 - ✓ Title of the paper (Also distinguish whether paper II or III)
 - ✓ Name of the Research Scholar.
 - ✓ Name of Supervising Teacher.
- Vi) If the syllabus of any paper is same for more than one candidate under the same guide or different guides the Chairman may entrust setting of the questions to any of the guides and forward to the CSS the question paper approved by him/her. In such cases the name of all candidates appearing for the examination be clearly indicated on the question paper cover. The cover should contain N + 3 copies (where N is the number of Candidates).
- vii) Envelopes containing the Question Papers for each paper for all the research scholars taking the Course Work Exam under a Doctoral Committee shall be enclosed in a sealed bundle by the Chairman to the Vice-Chairman (CSS). The same procedure may be followed in respect of paper III also.
- viii) The Chairman, Doctoral Committee shall convey his approval of the Question Papers placed in the bundle, in the forwarding letter enclosed with the bundle.
- ix) Change in the title of the Research topic announced after the date of this circular will not be entertained.

7. Valuation of answer scripts: The following instructions may be observed in this respect:

- i) The answer scripts of Paper I 'Research Methodology' shall be forwarded to the Vice-Chairman (CSS) with the attendance sheet and forwarding letter in sealed cover, immediately after the examination.
- ii) The answer scripts of Papers II & III are to be given to the supervising Teachers concerned, who will, after valuation, forward the valued answer scripts along with the mark list and a copy of the Question Paper to the Chairman, Doctoral Committee.
- iii) It shall be the duty of the Chairman, Doctoral Committee to forward to the Vice-Chairman (CSS) the valued answer scripts together with the attendance sheet and Mark list duly countersigned by him,

Instructions:

Two sets of Question Papers are to be prepared for each paper.(Four copies of each question papers should be put in sealed envelopes duly approved by the Chairman, Doctoral Committee).

The Question Papers is to be submitted to the Vice Chairman, (CSS) not later than **15.12.2018**.

It should be forwarded by the Chairman, Doctoral Committee, clearly stating that the question papers are approved by him/her.

Paper – I “Research Methodology” Answer scripts are to be handed over to the Vice – Chairman, (CSS) on the same day of Examinations.

Paper II & III are to be given to the supervising teachers concerned for valuation. The valued answer scripts are to be handed over to the Vice- Chairman, (CSS) along with the copy of the question paper and the mark list duly approved by the Chairman, Doctoral Committee. The attendance sheet of all 3 Papers are to be forwarded to the Vice- Chairman, CSS after Paper III Examination on or **before 10.01.2019**.

If there is any change in the title of Paper II/III, an attested copy of the U.O. concerned is to be submitted to the Vice-Chairman, (CSS), before the submission of Question paper. Requests for change of title after the submission of question papers to the Vice- Chairman, (CSS) will not be considered.

Each sets of question papers are to be sent in separate sealed envelopes. Super scribing the name of paper, title, the name of the candidate and the name of the supervising teacher.


