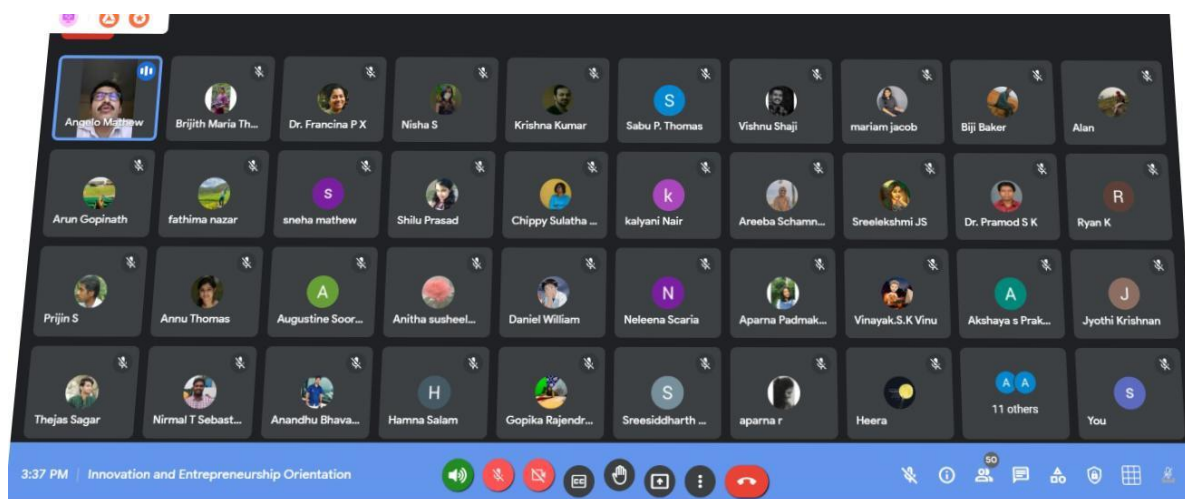
INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP ORIENTATION PROGRAM

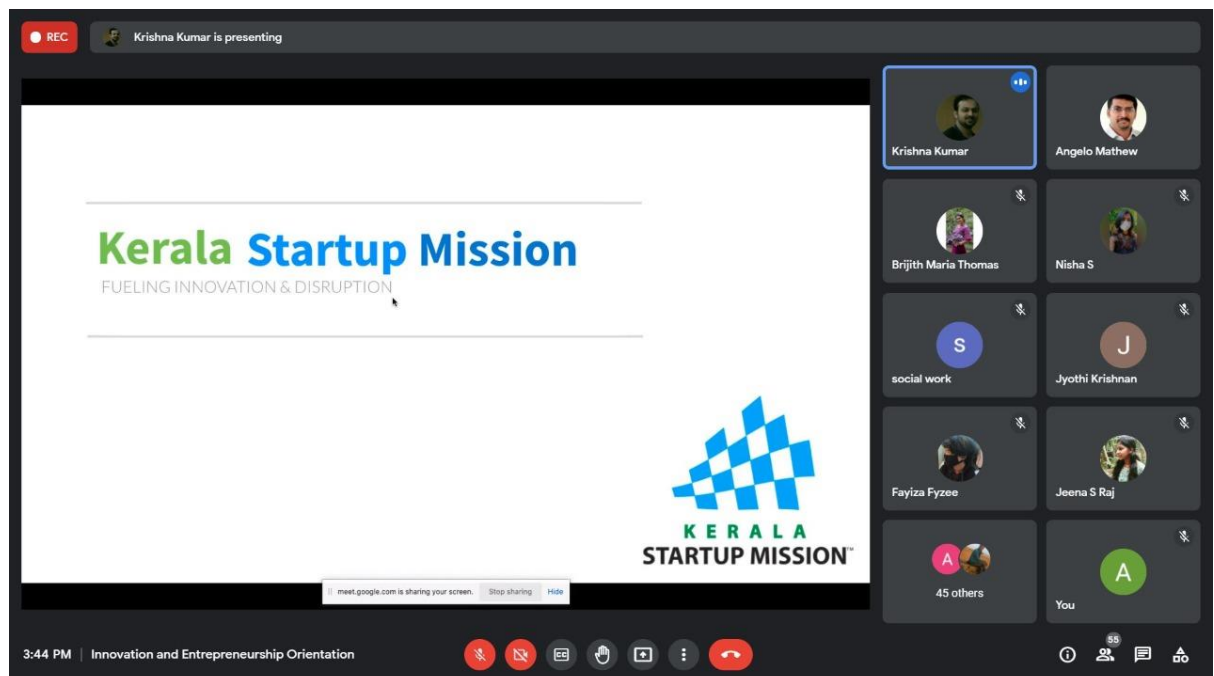
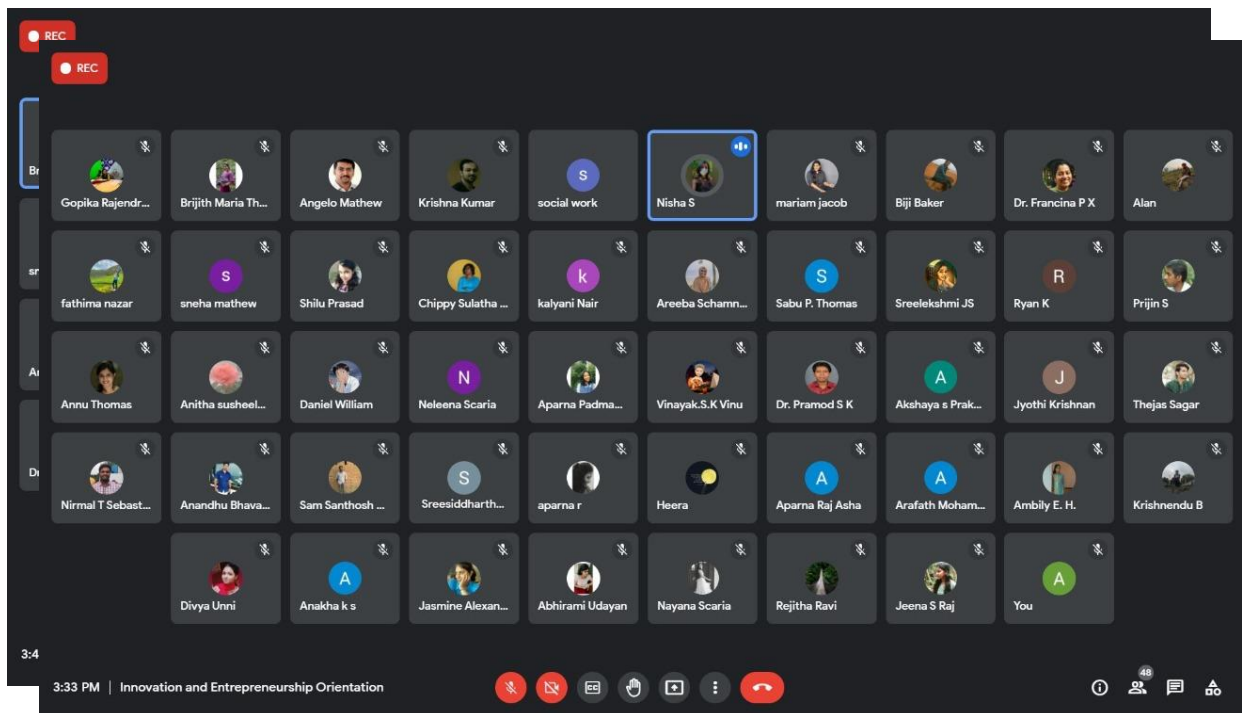
The Innovation Club of Loyola College of Social Sciences, Thiruvananthapuram in association with Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Cell (IEDC) under Kerala Startup Mission has conducted an orientation program on the topic 'Innovation and Entrepreneurship'. The purpose of the program was to transform postgraduate students into promising individuals by creating an understanding of entrepreneurship and an innovative outlook of the competitive world. The program was held on the 24th of September 2021 through the online Google meet platform from 3.30 pm to 4.30 pm and around 80 students took part in it. Mr. Krishnakumar, the project lead at Kerala Startup Mission was the chief guest of the occasion.

Ms. Brijith Maria Thomas from the Department of Disaster Management was the emcee for the event. Ms. Nisha S from the Department of Counselling Psychology has proposed the welcome address. Fr. Dr. Sabu P Thomas SJ, the Vice Principal & Bursar of Loyola College of Social Sciences addressed his remarks at the event. Dr. Angelo Mathew, the Nodal Officer of IEDC and Assistant Professor of the Department of Personnel Management gave a brief introduction regarding the program.

Then there was a PowerPoint presentation and a detailed discussion on the topic. Mr. Krishnakumar gave an idea about Kerala Startup Mission and described how to develop business ideas, the benefits of startups, the registration and the funding processes etc. He also construed the idea of 'Fail Fast or Succeed' which is a notion highly related to startup businesses. He also mentioned the top 10 startup mistakes and defined the various ecosystem of startups. He also exhibited a video presentation about the infrastructure of the Kerala Startup Mission.

At the end of the session, there was an interactive Q&A part. The resource person answered the queries of students. Although the program was online, it succeeded to bridge the gap between online limitations and face to face interactions. Dr. Andrew Michael, Assistant Professor of the Department of Sociology, provided all the technical support needed for the event. Mr. Anandhu B S from the Department of Sociology remarked vote of thanks. The program created a great enthusiasm in young entrepreneurs. It also gave a clear insight about how to begin a startup, the limitations and the registration processes and so on. The program was done very well and appreciated by everyone.
