# Loyola Research Centre

## **Annual Report**

The activities of the Loyola Research Centre during the period 2020-2022 have been co-ordinated under the leadership of Dr. Nisha Jolly Nelson as research coordinator. Sunitha R and Minu Jose have served as student coordinator and assistant coordinator respectively between 27<sup>th</sup> February 2020 and January 2022.

Currently, Loyola Research Centre (LRC) has thirty-eight (38) research scholars, of which twenty-seven (27) are full- time scholars and eleven (11) are part-time scholars, pursuing PhD in Social Work, Sociology and Management studies. This include three (3)scholars who have submitted their thesis after presubmission. Thus, the current list of scholars whose research is in progress include twenty-six(26) full time scholars and nine(9)part time scholars forming a total of thirty-five (35) research scholars.

Four Faculties, Dr. Jasmine Sera Alexander, Dr. Fr. Sabu P. Thomas, and Dr. Francina. P.X (Department of Social Work) and Dr. Uthara Soman (Department of Sociology) obtained guideship under the Loyola Research Centre during the period 2020-2022. During the same period, sixteen (16) research scholars of which four (4) in Social Work, seven (7) in Sociology and five (5) in Management, joined Loyola Research Centre for PhD. Sadly, Loyola has lost one part- time scholar, Ms. Lekshmi Kutty under Dr. Anitha Sin Management, due to Covid 19 pandemic.

Ms. Remya R and Praveen P research scholars under Dr. Sunil John J and Ms. Athira Narayan under Dr. Nisha Jolly Nelson who joined as full-time scholars initially, converted their research status to part time as they are employed now.

Due to Covid-19 pandemic and lock down condition, the college was closed between 11<sup>th</sup> March 2020 and 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2021. Again, during the second wave of Covid-19 pandemic, the research scholars of the college opted for work from home option and it continues till 4<sup>th</sup>October 2021. During this period, the research forum conducted all meetings and knowledge sharing sessions through virtual platforms like Zoom, Google meet, Moodle and so on and academic news and notifications were shared through scholar's WhatsApp group.

### **Activities Initiated:**

The programmes and activities initiated by the research centre are mainly based on the concerns, suggestions and recommendations raised by scholars during the time of monthly meetings and discussions held on scholars what's app group. The activities conducted are as follows.

### **Annual Report**

The activities of Loyola Research Centre for the year 2019-20 has been co-ordinated under the leadership of Dr. Nisha Jolly Nelson (Dept. of Sociology). Research Scholars, Athira Narayanan and Rasmy Kiran served as Student Coordinator and Assistant Coordinator respectively during the period 27<sup>th</sup> February 2019 to 26<sup>th</sup> February 2020.

For the current year LRC has a total of 21 full time scholars and 10 part time scholars pursuing PhD in Social Work, Sociology and Management. This includes 10 Scholars who have submitted their Thesis for evaluation after Pre-submission and 2 Scholars who have just completed their Pre-submission. Hence the current list of Scholars whose research is in progress includes 15 Full time and 4 part time scholars. For the year 2019, there were 4 new research scholars in Sociology and Social work department and one scholar in Management under Dr.Raju G (faculty of CET, Trivandrum). Ms Arya Gopinath, research scholar under Dr. Sonny Jose and Ms. Anita A Mathew under Dr. Nisha Jolly Nelson who joined as full time scholars initially, converted their research status to part time as they are employed now. The researches forum of the Centre meets every month Conduct academic presentation of scholars, engage in knowledge sharing sessions and shares academic news and notifications through Whatsapp group.

#### **Actions Taken**

- 1. <u>Presentation of Scholars</u>: Based on the inputs of the annual meeting 2018-19, continuous conduct of Academic presentation of Scholars was ensured. Total of 14 presentations were conducted during the period.
- 2. Concerns raised and addressed through monthly meetings:

The main concerns raised by scholars during the monthly meeting was the inconvenience caused due to unavailability of room for the Scholars. Another issue was lack of chairs, desk and extension cords. Nisha Miss discussed the issue with our Vice Principal Sabu Achan and cleared the issue soon. Sufficient chairs and tables were provided and the missing cords replaced in the Research scholars room.

### Other suggestions were to,

- (1) Start knowledge sharing sessions from faculties of Loyola on Methodology and related areas of research.
- (2) New Scholars to be introduced in the Whatsapp group instead of just adding their number and subsequently in the following monthly meeting.
- (3) New scholars expressed their need for an Orientation session to get more insight on how to go forward with their research.
- (4) Arranging minimum attendance for Pre-submission is still an issue and hence has requested all Scholars to cooperate and be available for such deliberations though they are on Duty Leave. Constraints if any, should be intimated in advance.

#### **Research Scholars Data Base**

A central repository with the details of Research Scholars of Loyola has been created and rolled out in google sheets. This includes information including Topic of research, Date of registration, contact details, name of research guide, current status of research etc. The same is shared with edit permission among research supervisors and scholars for their convenience.

#### Medical Assistance from "Orupidi Ariyum Orupara Chiriyum" Fund

The fund was collected for welfare activities by Scholars during the year 2015-16 amounting to Rs 1,23,250/-. After catering to such welfare activities in the year 2016-17, balance of Rs 68,562/- was deposited to the College bank account.

One of our fellow Scholars, Ms.Ligin K L suffered from an autoimmune disorder that eventually resulted in Renal impairment. She is currently undergoing Dialysis and looking forward for a Kidney transplant within a year. Written request for Medical assistance was submitted to our Vice Principal, Sabu Achan in this regard on 20-Nov-2019. An amount of Rs.50,000/- was transferred to her account on 5 Dec 2019 from the balance of Orupidi Ariyum Orupara Chiriyum Fund. She had acknowledged the receipt with gratitude and thanked the College management and scholars for the timely support.

#### ANNUAL REPORT
