

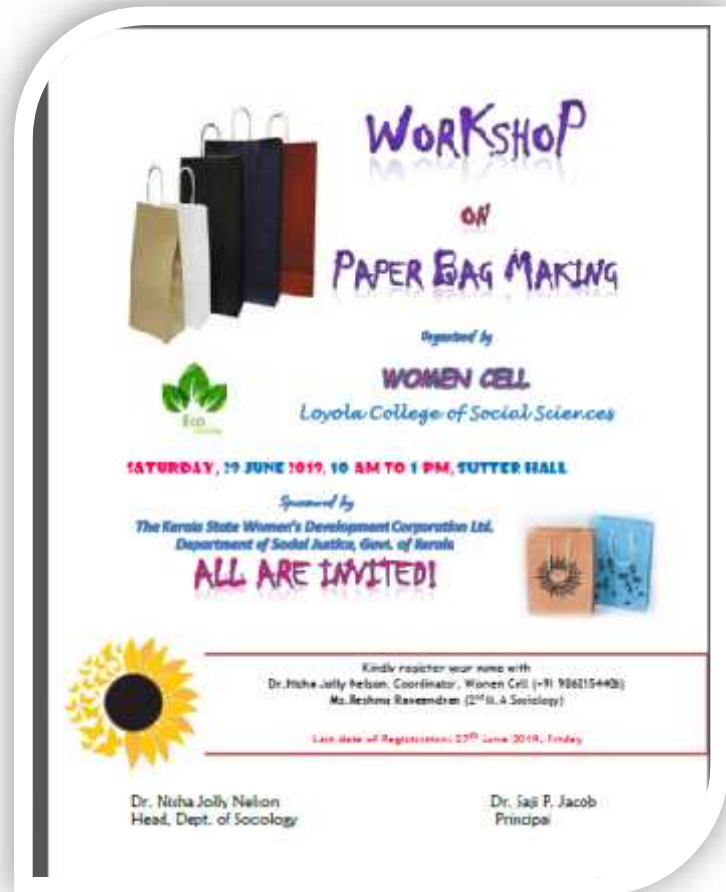

The participants were delighted with this session as they were able to understand the importance of this campaign and also were able to look at a new business opportunity for themselves.

As per description the students used old newspapers, magazine pages and charts and threads to make attractive bags of all shapes and sizes. It was a very informative and useful session.
