CLAUSE 1 CO-PERATION

Background

As part of initiating the competence enhancement management model on the campus, the academic body at Loyola has developed a five-dimensional approach on campus. One of the key dimensional areas is programme management. One of the strongholds of Loyola in programme management used to be its unique PIMER model. It uses this framework in planning, implementing, monitoring, evaluating, and reframing all its significant activities on the campus. However, realising the significance of project management skills in enhancing the employment prospects of postgraduates in today's drastically reshaping labour market, Loyola has taken the resolution to give more attention to imparting project management-related skills to its students.

Against this background, Loyola has explored the possibilities of starting a student forum of the Project Management Institute¹(www.pmi.org) on the campus. Through the network of Mr Anish Pappachan, an alumni member of the college, weapproachedthe PMI Trivandrum, Kerala Chapter (www.pmikerala.org), a local chapter of PMI located in the southern tip of India, for this purpose. After getting a positive node from the officials of the PMI Kerala Chapter, we had an online meeting on 28th May 2021 to further deliberate on the establishment of a PMI Academic forum²i at Loyola. In this meeting, all the HoD's, Principal, Fr. Ranjit and Mr Anish participated in the meeting representing Loyola, and all its major office bearers represented PMI. We have subsequently signed an MoU with the PMI Kerala Chapter for better academic collaboration on 29th July 2021. Fr. Ranjit George SJ is the staff coordinator, and Dr Aby Tellas is the student animator to facilitate further the activities of the student forum on the campus.

- Support to achieve PMI Kickoff Waterfall & Agile Badges



- 2. Official Inauguration of the student forum at Loyola on 13th August 2021
- 3. Membership campaign
- 4. Participation in Wings 2021 by some of the member students- An annual academic conclave organised by PMI Kerala Chapter to facilitate effective exchanges with the academia and industry
- 5. Staff in charge participating in Waves 2021 held on the first and second October 2021
- 6. The election of the office-bearers of the student forum on 5th October 2021
- 7. Completion of Waterfall/Agile Badges by the students
- 8. Students as Volunteers for developing learning content to support the visually impaired learners
- 9. PMI also offer a nine-week PM Ready Certificate course to the member students at a subsidised rate to equip them to take up PM-related jobs in the future. The first batch commenced on 23rd October 2021.
