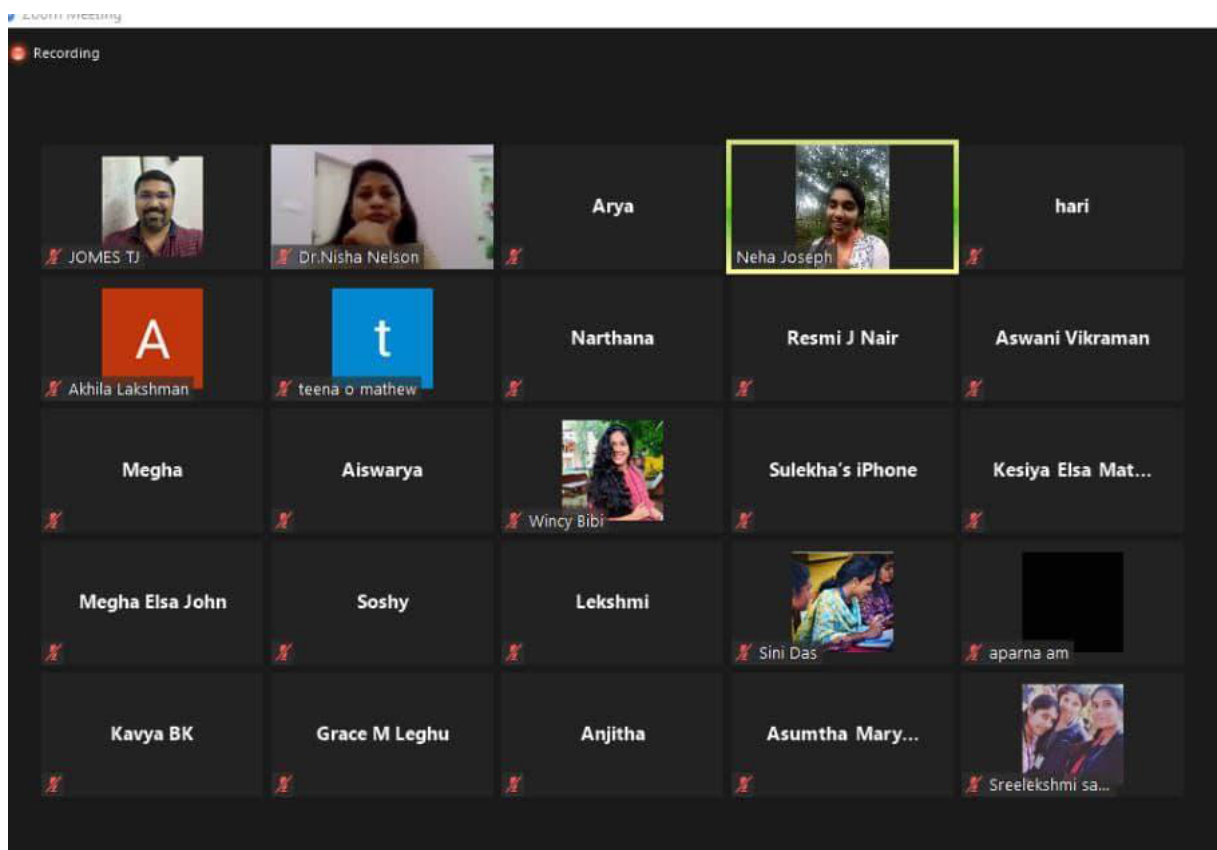
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Annual Report for the Year 2020-21

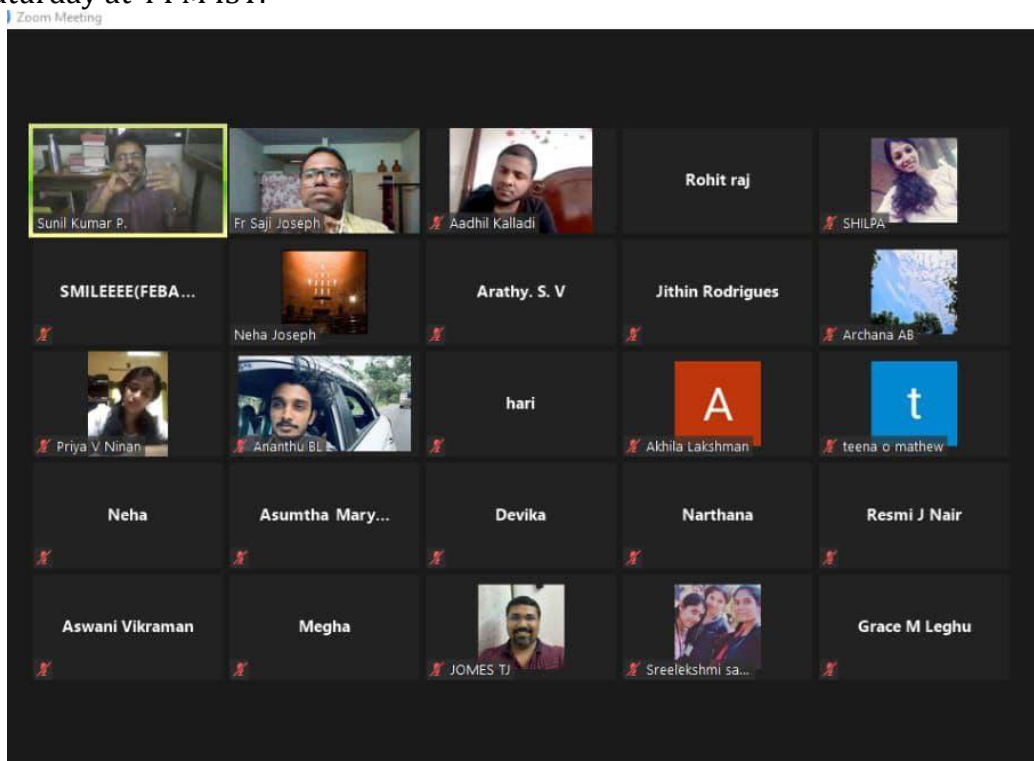
Forming a Collaborative Working Plan towards Each Career Milestone

Loyola Academy of Career Enhancement (LACE) conducted a session on 8th August 2020 through online platform Zoom at 4 pm. The team welcomed new members to the group warmly and got to know each other and their dream aspirations in career. The new members were oriented towards the LACE student program. The members had actively voiced their expectations and concerns regarding on how and by what means to work towards each goal posts step by step. It was a common consensus that a buddy group needs to be formed in the program so a feeling of warmth, encouraging and open space to learn, learn from mistakes, address to concerns, support each other to work hands on to develop clarity and focus on career goals, skill sets and mutually support each other in working on self- development non-judgmentally in a less stressful, productive and fun way. During the meeting it was decided to keep open to adding suggestions and workable expectations to members who were not be able to attend the meeting and flexible enough to meet the need and pace of the team. It was decided to circulate the brainstormed and formulated workable plan during the meeting to the LACE members who were not to attend the meeting for various reasons so everyone would be updated and feel welcomed to contribute towards the working plan.

The meeting attendees had a consensus that a weekly gathering on Saturday is required and since the main requirements to be catered consistently the meeting would be divided into mini sessions. It would also break monotony during the work and practice as well, to stay inspired throughout the session and enjoy the work towards the goal. It was commonly agreed that one of the main goal post of the team is to qualify various competitive exams and also requires more time to work. It was also agreed that the team would weekly work together and maintain the practice offline daily. The mini sessions would be on (a) self- work session- which helps in forming clarity on goals, self-development and skill sets hands on, (b) weekly current affair reading and discussion to keep everyone update and cover the current affairs section in general paper, (c) one main current affair would be decided on the following week prior the next meeting for elaborate discussion and note making, (d) a general paper topic or subject topic would be covered through discussion and subject paper, (e) preparation tips for competitive exam

preparation, (f) cool down session and planning the next working agenda. However, there may be variations in session to cater to the team's need and priority which includes wellbeing, stress management by having lighter session when required by spending time on infotainment through various creative games, arts, having a short film or documentary day based on a general paper portion and have discussion. The common medium of learning includes group discussion, group note contributing and circulating, group hands on work outs on various skill sets, practice questions utilizing various reliable books, online materials, video and audio tutorials, short films and documentaries on various topics required for the competitive exams, self- made notes, peer presentations and invite external trainers. It was commonly decided and agreed upon that every week on Saturday at 4 PM IST is a convenient time to spend for working on our weekly agendas towards our goal posts.

The agenda of the next meeting is to cover micro sessions of (a) self-work- hands on working out goal attainment worksheet, (b) reading of current affair updates of the week and discussion, (c) elaborate discussion and point collection of one major current affair topic, (d) collaborative formation of the team syllabus by compiling general paper syllabus topics based on priority and practice time required (e) note preparation tip while reading newspaper for competitive exam preparation and (f) cool down time and planning next meeting agenda. The next meeting date and timing was commonly decided on 15th August 2020, Saturday at 4 PM IST.

First Official Session and Discussion Forum

LACE conducted its first official session by incorporating mini sessions within it on 15th August 2020 at 4pm. The session was conducted through the online platform zoom. Four mini sessions were planned for the day-a) Self-work b) weekly current affair reading c) A small discussion on '*New education Policy 2020*' d) UGC Net and civil service syllabus discussion and compiling it.

The first mini session was on self-work, which aims to bring clarity on goals, self-development and skill. The session was handled by Sreedevi ma'am (staff coordinator of LACE). It was formulated through a worksheet format by contemplating certain questions relating to our goals. It was more over a kind of self evaluation of our goals and questions tries to analyze it critically. When we list our goals, it becomes meaningful, but if it's not done, it's just a dream. This is the aim of self work. This mini session lasted for 20 minutes.

The second mini session was on reading weekly current affairs. It was handled by Kesiya (Second Year MSW). She compiles the current affairs of two weeks and presented well. It covered the entire aspects of news by focusing on all areas like International, National, Regional and Sports. It was decided that weekly current affairs would be compiled monthly and it will be uploaded in *Moodle* at the end of every month. Finally students will get the combined version which will be a solid study material. At the same time weekly ones which are read in sessions will be circulated through our official Whatsapp group within that week. So that students will be updated with the events. The session lasted for 17 minutes.

Third mini session was on a small discussion on *National Education Policy 2020*. The session started with a general discussion. But later it was decided to focus on section wise discussion. Sreedevi ma'am circulated a PDF related to the topic and we had a small discussion on it. Moreover it became a one side discussion where Ma'am discussed the points from PDF. Students agreed that they will go through the notes and will continue the discussion next week. The session lasted for 35 minutes. The time got exceeded so it was decided to drop the next session which was planned to discuss on syllabus. It will be followed up in next week. The agenda for the next meeting was decided. It has planned to select buddy pair for each other. After the formation of buddy pair, the discussion on '*National Education Policy 2020*' will be continued followed by syllabus discussion. Students

gave their suggestions on how to improve the sessions. The next meeting is scheduled for 22nd August 2020 and the session got over by 6:30 PM.

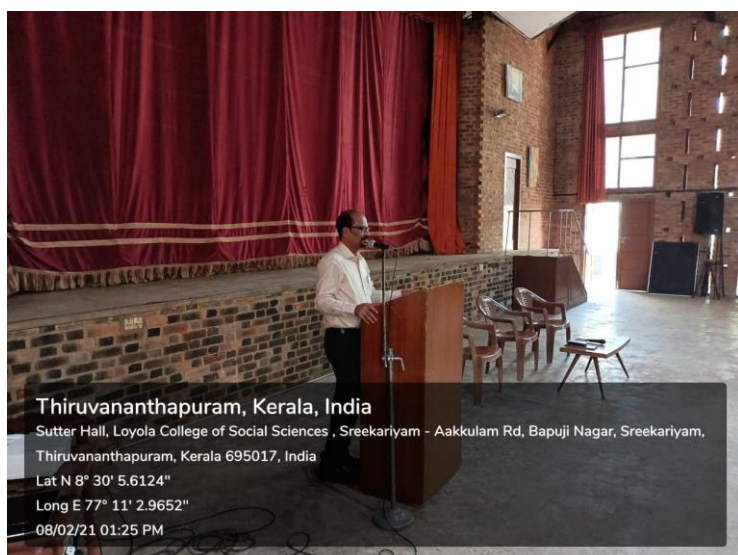
Report
