REPORT OF ARTS DAY 2020-21

The Annual Arts Day was held at Sutter Hall on the auspicious day of 29th March 2021. The official inaugural function had begun at 10:00 am. The chief guest of the function was acclaimed film actress Arthana Binu who was also an alumni of Loyola College of Social Sciences. The function began with a prayer by the college choir. It was followed by the welcome speech of Dr.Nisha Jolly Nelson, Arts Club Advisor, HOD Dept of Sociology. After the welcome speech, Principal Dr. Saji P Jacob gave the Presidential Address. The Arts Day function was inaugurated by film actress Arthana Binu by lighting the lamp. The felicitation address was given by Vice Principal Dr. Sabu P Thomas. The introduction of judges was done by Dr. Angelo Mathew, Arts Club Advisor, Asst. Professor, HRM Department. It was followed by vote of thanks which was delivered by Ms. Anna Elias, Arts Club Secretary.



The formal inaugural function got concluded by 10:30 am and it was followed by cultural programs. The cultural programs were planned to be conducted in two venues. Light music, English and Malayalam recitation, Elocution, Group song, Folk

song and Duet song were conducted in JM Hall whereas Monoact, Mimicry, Group dance, Mime, Fancy dress, Tableu and Thiruvathira were conducted in Sutter Hall.Programs such as light music and mimicry were conducted before the inauguration.There were both individual items as well as group items.



As per the rules of the Arts Day Celebrations, each person can participate in a maximum of three individual items and two group items. There can be a maximum of two entries for individual competitions from a group, whereas group entries shall be restricted to only one except for duet song. There should be a minimum of three entries from at least two groups for an item of competition. For individual items, the points for various positions are, first place – five points, second place – three points and third place – two points. For group items, the points for various positions are, first place – ten points, second place – six points and third place – two points. There is one point for participation. The team should enter the stage before two minutes after the starting bell, or else the entry will be cancelled. Participation in individual items, which are conducted on Arts Day, only will be considered for the award of Kalathilakam and Kalaprathibha.All

individual and group items were conducted as per the time schedule. Finally the Arts Day Celebrations were concluded at 3:00 pm.

Regarding the points and score card of the participants for the Arts Day Celebrations, Group 1 Double Barrel received a score of 62, Group 2 Minnalpada received a score of 56, Group 3 Killadis received a score of 77 and Group 4 Samrat received a score of 70. For the Sports Day Celebrations, Group 1 Double Barrel received a score of 97, Group 2 Minnalpada received a score of 88, Group 3 Killadis received a score of 52 and Group 4 Samrat received a score of 157. The grand total scores of the four groups were 159, 144, 129 and 227. Group 4 Samrat emerged as the highest scorer in the Arts and Sports Day Celebrations. Second place was bagged by Double Barrel and the Golden Jubilee College Union Ever Rolling Cricket Trophy was awarded to Minnalpada.
