Alumni Get-together at Loyola, 2018









Research

Along the same lines 5 of our alumni (read 'alumni collective') - Sherin Wilfred (MSW2016), Kannan GS (MSW2017), Vandana Suresh, Anithamol Babu and Gilda Mani (MSW 2018), teachers teamed up with Dr. Sonny Jose and Dr. Angelo Mathew of Department of PM to complete CSR evaluation study on four projects - Sanghamaithri Fruits and Vegetable Cooperative, Prathibhatheeram (by Dr.TM Thomas Issac), Sree Lekshmivilasom Mala-araya Cooperative and Sree Ramakrishna Mission Hospital - funded by Cochin Shipyard Limited and filed the draft Social Impact report.

Resurgence in the wake of COVID-19

There was a SOS from SS Samathi, Mayyanad as 10 of their caregivers were positive and they were struggling to care for the 256 strong population. Six of our students volunteered and went into quarantine and then started their field work at this rehabilitation centre. We also placed our students with Benedictine Menni Home and Pallium India thanks to the willing support by the management of which our students were a part; the same was followed by TSSS and BluePoint, our long-time collaborators. Good many of them manned community kitchens, while one of them, Rameez MS had his own initiative UNDO (literally translating into the compassionate question of "did you have food?"). Others such as Sandra Johnson and Anna George assisted school managements to organize exams amidst COVID protocols. A team of seven supported



ATOM International in reaching out to school students and their parents isolated during the COVID outbreak. Anna George went a step further to fundraise money for Ottamasseri coastal community during the lockdown. The first of student engagement found them engaging from 120-140 hours with the District Child Protection Unit, TSSS, Bethsada, Muvattupuzha; SS Samithi, Mayyanad; Maxminds, Kannur. The second bout had them engaging from 130-150hours with District Probationary Offices - Pathanathitta, Kollam, Ernakulam and Muvattupuzha, Nehru Yuva Kendra, SHREYAS (Wyanad), District Child Protection Unit-Thiruvananthapuram and Dale View.
