

Dear Sir,

This is with regard to certain modifications to be made to the syllabus of the MSW programme in Disaster Management being offered by the Kerala University.

The third and fourth semesters consist of specialisation related courses, viz courses related to Technology and Health. While teaching courses under this programme, the Technology related specialisation papers have been found to be highly technical.

Students come from diverse backgrounds, many having pursued social sciences at the under graduate level, which makes it difficult for them to grasp heavily technical courses. That also makes it difficult to deliver these highly technical courses in an effective manner.

Hence it is proposed that a few modifications be made to the following courses, so that they become lighter and easier for the students.

Course No. 35 ICT for Disaster Management- 3rd Semester

Course No. 36 Geographical Information System in Disaster Management – 3rd Semester

Course No.37 Science and Technology for Risk Assessment, Prevention and Preparedness – 3rd Semester


Course No. 38 Digital Image Processing and Image Analysis – 4th Semester

Course No.39 GIS and GPS Technologies in Disasters – 4th Semester

Course No. 40 Geo-Informatics and Applications in Disasters – 4th Semester

Kindly initiate steps to bring in these modifications into the syllabus.


